Grooming Services for Men and Women

Homelessness is a complex issue that affects people in a variety of ways. In addition to providing shelter and basic necessities, homeless shelters can play an important role in helping individuals rebuild their lives and regain a sense of dignity and self-worth. One way to support this effort is by establishing a barber shop at the shelter, where residents can receive grooming services by volunteers at no cost.



Currently, volunteers come on a monthly basis to provide haircuts for residents at our men's center but often have to set up shop in our classrooms or living spaces. The new barber shop will be located by the welcome center and have appropriate accommodations for both men and women receiving haircuts.

Grooming is an important aspect of job readiness, and having access to a barber shop can help residents prepare for job interviews, employment opportunities and feel connected to the greater community.
