The Renew Center will provide designated beds for those suffering from mental health needs that may not be able to function within our large group settings. Renovations will include our modern Step-Up Beds with living space, a separate shower and bathroom area as well as meeting space for partner agencies to facilitate their mental health care.

The Opportunity

We do not turn away residents who are suffering from mental health challenges, however, they may struggle in our environment and their reactions can result in disciplinary procedures. To address this dynamic we will dedicate a specific area of the facility to provide services, relational staff time and space for those experiencing mental health challenges.

As a shelter we are able to require medication compliance in order to stay in our facility. This is a positive element in addressing the mental health needs of our broader community. By providing this additional space within the shelter we hope to partner with Mental Health professionals who can create stability for the homeless suffering from mental health challenges.

Who We Can Reach

Our target audience for the mental health bed space will be:

- * Individuals who are not a danger to self or others and are able to function within our environment.
- * Individuals who have received care from the KCPD Crisis Center but are still experiencing a crisis and need longer residential care and case management.
- * The homeless population suffering from mental illness, particularly targeting the undiagnosed who are not actively receiving services from the mental healthcare system.
- * The unsheltered homeless population served through our outreach program who may not have access to other mental health providers.

How We Will Serve

The Renew Program will intake clients into our 14-day emergency shelter and assess their mental health needs. If our Renew program is a fit, the primary goal will be to gain stability in order for the individual to become capable of successfully completing a case plan or entering the CCOR program.

If our Renew Program is not a fit, the client will be referred to a partnering mental health provider for a psychiatric visit and additional care.

Success for clients entering our Renew Program is defined as:

- * Medication compliance
- * Meeting with a mental-health trained staff member and working a case plan
- * Completing a psychiatric review and documented progress towards addressing mental healthcare needs.
