A Dedication and Memorial to former employee Michael Williams

In honor of long time servant, friend and previous employee Michael Williams, Shelter KC is dedicating the new C-COR living space in his honor.

Michael was hired as an evening cook in the Missions kitchen where he quickly became a "Light on a Hill" as his cheerful spirit and powerful witness spurred a ministry beyond food that touched the lives of volunteers, clients and staff.

Serving dinner and hosting volunteers was his role, but his true work was to point people to Jesus, and to make sure everyone he encountered felt seen and known.

Michael eventually transitioned to becoming a C-COR counselor prior to his retirement. He continued to apply his profound knowledge of Scripture and testimony as he helped nurture the recovery process of men in the C-COR program.

In 2023, Michael transitioned to his heavenly home after battling a long illness. In memory of his significant imprint on the Mission and all who encountered him, we intend to honor his memory and living testimony by dedicating the new C-COR lounge in his honor, naming it the Williams Commons.
